### Who is eligible?

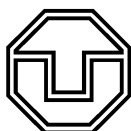

### Possible aims of a proposed stay abroad

- development of new or continuation of ongoing projects in the field of diabetes and/or depression
- networking with facilities of our partner-universities
- preparation of applications for third-party funds concerning mutual projects

### Duration of the stay

- Between 15 days and 6 months

Containing aim of the stay and expected benefit from it, previous connections to the visited facility and in case of ongoing projects specification of thesis and partner facility  
*Doctoral candidates:* outline the benefit to your ongoing/planned thesis
- *approval from head of structural unit*  
*Doctoral candidates:* approval from group leader or supervisor
- *CV*  
*Doctoral candidates:* CV and testimonials (university studies, internships, etc.)
- *Overview of own publications/talks/research projects*
