### **Who is eligible?**

- Students enlisted as doctoral candidates at TU Dresden or who plan to start their doctoral thesis at TU Dresden in the near future, focusing on diabetes and/or depression
- Or
- Scientific staff in facilities of TU Dresden or University Hospital Carl Gustav Carus with ongoing projects or visions for new research prospects in the area of diabetes and/or depression

### **Possible aims of a proposed stay abroad**

- development of new or continuation of ongoing projects in the field of diabetes and/or depression
- networking with facilities of our partner universities
- preparation of applications for third-party funds concerning mutual projects

### **Duration of the stay**

- Between 15 days and 6 months
- **Exception:** scientific staff who plan to stay at King's College London are eligible for short-term stays of less than 15 days

- *Project outline*  
Containing aim of the stay and expected benefit from it, previous connections to the visited facility and in case of ongoing projects specification of thesis and partner facility  
*doctoral candidates:* outline the benefit to your ongoing/planned thesis
- *approval from head of structural unit*  
*doctoral candidates:* approval from group leader or supervisor
- *CV*  
*doctoral candidates:* CV and testimonials (university studies, internships, etc)
- *Overview of own publications/talks/research projects*

Staff will receive reimbursement of all travel and accommodation costs according to BRKG / ARV and DAAD project guidelines.

*Doctoral students:* fixed allowance
